Dear Kiwanians,

As we watch daily the carnage the worst floods in living memory have wrought on the families in Johor, Kiwanians must respond and magnificently.

Governor Adeline has asked that we launch the Kiwanis Flood Relief Fund (KFRF) immediately to assist families who were affected by the disaster. So far Division 2 has responded and some clubs in the Klang valley – but lets make this a Kiwanis Malaysia Affair. Our own children are suffering and need help – we must act quickly.

I ask that clubs take the following steps:

1. Donate to the KFRF by sending funds from their service account to the Kiwanis Malaysia District as soon as you get your Board approval. Write your cheques to “Kiwanis Malaysia” and mark the back “KFRF” with you clubs name
2. Start a fund raising campaign in your community for the KFRF immediately.
3. Ask youth clubs to help (Circle K’ers to raise funds on the LRT)
4. You can follow this by collecting through donations or purchasing the following items:
 - Food items – Rice, baby food, bread, canned food and biscuits
 - Pillows, blankets, diapers, mats, toiletries
 - T Shirts, Track Bottoms, children’s clothes, school uniforms, school bags
